

KINGS/QUEENS
2008-09

1. This league shall bowl a schedule beginning August 18, 2008 with no bowling Labor Day. Shadow balls begin approx. 6:40pm, with league play beginning approx. 6:45pm. First night lineup will be determined by last year's standings.
2. Fees will be \$ 13.00 per person per week (\$ 9.75 bowling and \$ 3.25 prize fund). Teams must pay all five prize funds per week (\$16.25) even if they have less than five bowlers. Teams must remit \$ 65.00 for 5 bowlers x 35 weeks due weekly. The league will pay lineage for 36 weeks. Prize fees are contributed to the league's prize fund. Any shortage will be deducted from that team's prize monies at the end of season. Only two weeks of non-payment allowed by any individual bowler. A \$ 20.00 per team entry fee is due by Jan. 31 unless \$ 200.00 league sponsor is found, in which case no team entry fees due.
3. USBC membership fees \$19.00, are due the first week of bowling.
4. The team roster can consist of eight players maximum, with the sixth and seventh member not bowling or subbing on another team. Teams will consist of any combination of men and women. Playing strength is five per team.
5. In order to bowl the last three weeks (weeks 33, 34, 35), a bowler must have bowled nine games in this league.
6. A legal lineup consists of two bowlers, one of which must be on the team roster. Two bowlers must be ready to bowl at the end of the first frame, or forfeit the game.
7. The first night of bowling the average from last years King/Queens league (minimum 21 games) will be used. If no average from King/Queens league then highest book average will be used. If neither average then the first night, average will be figured after three games are bowled and handicap applied. The score of each game will be used as an average if bowler is unable to complete 3 games the first time bowling until a 3 game average is established. Vacancy score shall be 120.
8. Blind score is ten less than average. When using a blind and a sub, the blind is the absent bowler with the most games. If two blinds and they have the same number of games, the blind with the lowest average is to be used.
9. Seven point system will be used. 2-game; 1-series.
10. Individual handicap will be used. 80% from 220.
11. Tardy bowlers will be able to catch up until the end of the 5th frame of first game or beginning of 2nd and 3rd games.
12. A bowler must bowl 2/3rds of the season to be eligible for prizes.

13. Individual prizes shall be awarded. No bowler may win more than one individual prize, to be paid average 1st, then series, then game.
14. In case of emergency or inclement weather, bowling against scores will be permitted. Teams should notify league officers when unable to bowl during scheduled league time. Pre-bowling is permitted by teams or individuals. Make-up games must be bowled as a team only. Games should be made up within 2 weeks if possible, out of courtesy to the rest of the league, and/or before a position round.
15. In the event of a forfeit or bye, a team must bowl within 50 pins of their team average, 150 for series.
16. Should it be necessary to cancel bowling due to weather, the league officers will notify Franklin Lanes.
17. This league will be governed by USBC mixed rules and those of the league.
18. No kids in the bowling area.
19. Split Season >

This league will bowl a split season with 17 sessions in the first half and 17 sessions in the second half. The team leading the league after each session is the champion of that half. On the 35th week, the two winners will bowl for first place with remaining teams bowling a position round. This rolloff will be held on the middle pair of lanes (7-8) in the league. All other teams will be lined up beginning on lane one as per total points for season.

If two or more teams are tied for either half, they must bowl a 3 game rolloff before the 35th week playoff. If one team wins both halves, a position round will be bowled the 35th week based on total season standings.

Prize money will be distributed one week after end of season.
