1. League will consist of 13 teams with 4 members per team. We will bowl 36 weeks starting 8/19/08 and ending 4/21/08, with the banquet 4/28/08.
2. Cost of bowling is \$ 12.00 for 33 weeks. Certification fee is \$19.00 and due the first week of bowling.
3. Team line-up will be determined by team standings at the end of last season. Handicap for first week will be determined after three games. Handicap will be 90% of difference between bowler's average and 210. Blind score is 10 pins less than average. Vacancy is 120.
4. When using a blind and a sub, the blind score should be used for the absent member with the most games bowled. If two absentee scores are needed, the average of the absentee with the next highest number of games shall be used. When two absent members have the same number of games, the lower absentee score shall be used.
5. Individual pre-bowling is allowed. A legal line-up consists of two bowlers. A pre-bowl and/or a sub will count toward legal line-up. A team is allowed three subs. Tardy bowlers must be ready to bowl by the completion of the fourth frame of the first game or the completion of the first frame of second or third game. A bowler may bowl out game one or two and later return to bowl the remaining game or games of the series.
6. In order for a person to sub the last four (4) weeks of the season, she must have an average of nine (9) games. Each captain is responsible for their subs being sanctioned.
7. Bowling fees are due each week, unless the bowler is absent. Upon returning, all arrearage must be paid. NO PAY-NO PLAY !! (WIBC rule 109d). A bowler who wishes to withdraw from the league must give team captain and an officer two weeks notice, assure replacement, or pay for two weeks of bowling.
8. In case of unavoidable absence of an entire team, pre-bowling or post-bowling will be permitted. Team captain must notify the secretary, In the event of a forfeit, the opposing team must bowl within 40 pins of their team average to be awarded a game and within 120 pins for series. Team must obtain a print out. The postponement should be made up as soon as possible out of courtesy to the rest of the league.
9. Individuals must be a member of the league and bowl 1/2 of the season (54 games) to be eligible for individual prizes. Classes will be determined after 12 games. Most improved award will be determined from 21 game average. Only one award per person or team. \$5.00 fun prizes will be awarded at the banquet.
10. No children shall be permitted in bowling area while bowling is in session.

11. When Vanderburgh County schools are dismissed because of bad weather, there will be no bowling. If one week is missed, the season will be extended. If two are missed, one will be made up on a Monday morning at 9:30. If school is "weather delayed", league WILL bowl. If a team is unable to bowl due to weather, the team should do a make-up as soon as possible as a courtesy to the rest of the league.
12. Meetings will be held when necessary and one week before the beginning of bowling. Any attending member may vote. Elections will be held at the banquet.
13. The secretary/treasurer salary will be \$400.00.
14. The seven point system will be used, two per game, one for series.
15. USBC rules will prevail on all other matters.
16. This league will bowl a split season with position rounds on last week of first half (18<sup>th</sup> week) and last week of second half (35<sup>th</sup> week). A Playoff between winners of each half will be on 36<sup>th</sup> week with remaining teams bowling a position round based on full season. If one team has won both halves, a position round will still be bowled on the 36<sup>th</sup> week.

CHRISTMAS - Each team is to bring a finger food on 12-23-08. Each member, if they desire, is to bring a non-perishable food item for the Food Bank.

AWARD BANQUET - Each team is to bring a minimum \$ 5.00 door prize. Additional Door prizes will be left to the choice of the host team.
