

Wednesday Morning Industrial League Rules
2008-09

1. This league will consist of four members per team and bowl a schedule of 36 weeks. A split season will be bowled with 18 weeks the first half and 17 weeks the 2nd half with position rounds the 18th and 35th weeks. On the 36th week the winner of the 1st and 2nd half will bowl for the league championship. The rest of the league will bowl a position round on season standings. If two or more teams are tied for 1st place at the end of the half, a one game rolloff will be held immediately after bowling. If the same team has won both halves after the 17th week of the second half, league will still bowl a position round based on the season standings.
2. The first week of bowling, averages will be figured after three games are bowled and handicap applied. Handicap of 80% of bowlers average from 220 will be used. Vacancy score shall be 125.
3. Teams will draw for starting lanes the first week.
4. Two regular members must be ready to bowl before the completion of the first frame. No roving subs.
5. Tardy bowlers will be permitted to catch up if ready to bowl before the 5th frame of the first game or beginning of 2nd and 3rd games.
6. Absentees after the first week take a score of 10 pins below the regular season average of the absentee. Use regular average to figure team average.
7. New members or subs without average will figure average after 3 games are rolled. The score of each game will be used only if a new bowler is unable to complete 3 games on their first day of bowling and until a 3 game average is established.
8. Each member is responsible for their bowling fee each week and must pay it whether present or absent.
9. Individuals must bowl 2/3 of the season to be eligible for individual prizes.
10. No subs will be allowed to bowl the last 2 weeks before the end of each half or the play-off day if average is higher than the absent bowler. New members during last two weeks of season must have approval of captains and officers.
11. Cost of bowling for the season will be \$ 12.00 per week.
12. Any condition not covered in these rules shall be acted upon by the league officers and team captains.

13. Prize list to be established after league starts according to number of teams.
14. Trophies awarded for 1st place team, individual high avg., series, game. Individuals can win only one individual prize and trophy to be paid in order listed above.
15. A team bowling against blind team must bowl within 40 pins of their own team average to win the game, and 120 of total to win series.
16. No bowler may be more than two weeks in arrears in his bowling fees. A bowler that is two weeks in arrears is an ineligible bowler and may not bowl again until paid in full.
17. The standings will be based on a seven point system. Two points for games won, and one point for series.
18. Bowling against scores in case of an emergency will be permitted by teams. Only individuals may pre-bowl, but no more than half of season's games.
19. This league will be a men's and women's league sanctioned by USBC mixed.
20. The league will skip bowling on Dec. 24, 2008, but will bowl on Dec. 31.
