

By Laws
Wednesday Night Mixed League
2008-2009

1. This league shall bowl a schedule beginning August 13, 2008 and ending April ,29 2009. Shadow bowling begins at 6:25 p.m. and league play at 6:30 p.m.
2. Bowling fees will be \$13.00 per person per week, with no payment the last week. Fees are due weekly, with no more than 2 weeks of non-payment, at which time, FEES MUST BE PAID. **Week 35 fees are to be paid by Week 30**
3. Sponsor fee is \$25.00 per team, due by the 10th Week. Sanction fees are \$19.00 per person.
4. The team roster shall consist of six players maximum, with the sixth member not bowling on any other team. Teams will consist of all men or all women.
5. In order to bowl the last three weeks, a sub must have bowled nine games in this league.
6. The sixth person on a team must be established by the fifth week of bowling. If a team needs to get a different sixth person, they must get the approval of the Board of Directors in advance.
7. A legal lineup consists of at least three bowlers, two of which must be on the team roster. Three bowlers must be ready to bowl at the end of the first frame, or forfeit the game. No pacers allowed.
8. Men must sub for men, women for women only.
9. Bowlers will use their 2007- 2008 Wednesday Night Mixed average of at least 21 games for the first night of bowling. If no average in this league, they will use their year ending book average. All others will establish an average after three games bowled. Vacancy score will be 120 points for both men and women.
10. Blind score is ten points less than the absent player's average. When using a blind and a sub, the blind is the absent bowler with the most games bowled. If two blinds are required and they have the same numbers of games, the blind with the lowest average is to be used. In the event a person has begun to bowl and is unable to complete the series that persons average will be used as the blind for the remainder of the series.
11. A 7 point system will be used: 2 points per game 1 point for series.
12. Individual handicap will be used: 80% of 220.
13. Tardy bowlers will be able to catch up until the last bowler of the 5th frame.
14. A bowler must bowl two thirds (2/3) of the season to be eligible for individual prizes.
15. Prizes shall be awarded for individual actual/handicap bowling. Prizes will be awarded for highest dollar amount qualified for. If a bowler qualifies for 2 prizes with the same dollar amount, then series will take precedence over game. No bowler may win more than one individual prize except high average and most improved.
16. In the case of an emergency, bowling against scores will be permitted if the team notifies the league officers when unable to bowl during scheduled league time. Make-up games must be bowled as a team, not as individuals. Games should be made up as soon as possible out of courtesy to the rest of the league, and/or before a position round.
17. In the event of forfeit or bye, a team must bowl within 50 pins of their average per game and 150 for series.
18. Should it be necessary to cancel bowling due to weather, the league officers will notify Franklin Lanes and all team captains by 4:30 p.m.
19. This league will be governed by USBC for rules not covered here.
20. There will be position rounds week 20 and 35. The first and second place men's teams will bowl on lanes 1 & 2, and the first and second place women's teams will bowl on lanes 3 & 4 alternating 2 men and 2 women teams in order of position standing. Week 36 will be a FUN NIGHT that does not count in standings or averages.
21. No children will be allowed in the bowling area at any time.
22. Fun pot will be distributed in \$50.00 increments on fun night.
23. The Secretary will provide a copy of the By Laws, and Association Rule book to League Officers.
24. Sponsor trophies for first place men & women teams will be paid for from the prize fund.
25. In case of a tie for first place there will be a 1 game roll off immediately after bowling has finished on the last regular bowling night to determine the champion. In the case where any position other than first place is tied with the same amount of total games, then the order will be determined by total pins.
