

Franklin Lanes Parent Permission and Youth League Rules

Age Brackets:

Bantam >	8 years & Under
Prep >	9 years thru 11 years
Junior >	12 thru 14 years
Major >	15 thru 18 years
Senior >	19 thru 21 years

Rules:

1. All bowlers in GEUSBCYA leagues must have parent or guardian permission.
2. All members of GEUSBCYA leagues must pay a sanction fee of \$12.00.
3. Age determined as of August 1 preceding bowling season.
4. Bowling fees: Bantam, Prep, Junior, Major, three games each week = \$8.00 and must be paid whether present or absent. Bowling shoes are furnished free.
5. All GEUSBCYA bowlers are required to pay their bowling fees whether present or absent.
6. Only authorized GEUSBCYA league coaches are permitted to instruct bowlers on the lanes.
7. No one will be permitted in bowler's area except coaches.
8. Smoking will not be permitted during GEUSBCYA leagues.
9. Vacancy score shall be 100. Handicap shall be 90% of bowler's average from 200.
10. Absentee score will be ten pins less than the absentees average, using absentees average for handicap.
11. Games may be prebowed by individuals if bowled prior to or during league time. Pre-bowled games must be finished Monday thru Saturday before 4pm. Pre-bowled scores will count for league high awards for season provided they are printed out on printer and subject to approval of league coaches.
12. General playing rules of GEUSBCYA will be observed.

13. Individuals must bowl half of scheduled games in season to be eligible for an individual award to be presented in this order: High Average, then High Series, then High Game.
14. Dress must be in keeping with GEUSBCYA and Franklin Lanes rules and policies. No beer or objectionable wording permitted.
15. Tardy bowlers will be permitted to catch up if ready to bowl by completion of seventh frame. You will be permitted to catch up in the game in process but not games that have been completed.
16. At least one bowler from a team must be present or have pre-bowled in order not to forfeit.
17. If bowling unopposed, teams must bowl within 10 pins per bowler (i.e. 40 pins if four member team) to win the games.
18. Handicap (including first day) will be figured after 3 games are bowled. The score of each game will be used on if a new bowler is unable to complete three games on his/her first day of bowling and until a 3 game average is established.
19. Averages from previous session will carry forward and be used in new session with pins and games continuing to accumulate for entire bowling season (September to May). Team scores and records will start new with beginning of each new session.
20. A position round will be bowled on the last scheduled week.
21. Standing will be based on a seven point system. Two points for game and one point for series.
