SUNDAY SQUARES/HIS & HERS LEAGUE RULES 2007-08

1. This league will be known as the Sunday Squares/His & Hers League. League play will begin at 6:00 pm and will bowl every other Sunday.
2. All bowlers will be USBC sanctioned.
3. Each member will pay \$ 12.00 per week dues for bowling. Of this, \$ 9.50 will go for bowling and the rest for prize money and secretary's salary.
4. Authority of team captains will be according to the USBC rules. All members resigning must give two weeks notice to the secretary.
5. Averages shall be the first three games a bowler bowls in this league. The score of each game will be used only if a new bowler is unable to complete three games on the first night until a 3 game average is established. Members must begin by start of 4th frame, or the beginning of second and third games or carry a blind for that game.
6. Handicap of 80% of 220 per bowler will be used each week. The absentee score will be ten pins under the average. Vacancy score shall be 120.
7. Postponements-USBC rule book. Any and all rules not covered in this list will be covered by either USBC rules.
8. Members must bowl thirty-six games of the league schedule to be eligible for individual prizes. No team or individual can win more than one prize in any one group.
9. There will be no subs the last two nights of bowling except those who have already established an average of no less than 6 games of bowling.
10. The last night of this league will be a position night.
11. At least two regular members must be present by the end of first frame unless an emergency postponement is granted. A team must notify a league officer of postponement 48 hours in advance unless an emergency. The postponement committee consists of the three officers.

12. Bowling against scores may be permitted in the event the two teams cannot find time to bowl at the same time. The secretary should be notified and every effort should be made to make up the games by the next bowling night. Individuals only may pre-bowl in advance. These scores will count for league high awards at end of season. Make-up permitted by teams only.
13. This league will be a point league with two points for each game won and one point for series won. In the event of a tie, teams involved will have their prize monies added together and divided equally.
14. The last week's bowling fee will be due by 5th week.
15. Each team member is responsible for their bowling fee each week and must be paid whether present or absent. If bowler is two weeks in arrears, all fees owed must be paid in full upon third week or will be ineligible to bowl. If bowler is ruled ineligible and bowls, the team will forfeit the games the ineligible bowler bowled in.
16. If team bowls against a blind team or a forfeit situation, the team must earn the points by bowling at least the team average less 10 pins per player (within 40 pins of team average per game or 120 pins for series).
17. Teams will consist of 2 men and 2 women per team. Men must sub for men, and women for women.
18. Banquet fund money is awarded (1/2 on night of bowling and 1/2 at banquet as attendance prizes). You must be present at banquet to win attendance prizes.
19. This league will bowl a split season with position rounds on last week of first half (9<sup>th</sup> week), and last week of second half (17<sup>th</sup> week), and last week of season (18<sup>th</sup> week). A playoff between winners of each half will be on the 18<sup>th</sup> week for league championship.
