

FRANKLIN LANES SUMMER LEAGUE RULES

- 1 COST OF BOWLING
Adult three game leagues \$ 9.00 week (\$7.50 bowling-\$1.50 prize)
- 2 TEAM MEMBERSHIP - Subs permitted
Doubles league - 1 sub permitted - 1 bowler required for lineup.
Triples league - 2 subs permitted - 1 bowlers required for lineup.
Mixed & CoEd - (4 members) 3 subs permitted - 2 bowlers required
for legal lineup. Men must sub for men - Women
must sub for women in mixed leagues. Any
sanctioned bowler (men or women) may sub in CoEd.
- 3 AVERAGES & HANDICAPS
Handicap will be 80% of average from 220. The first week of
bowling, averages will be figured after series is completed and
handicap will then be applied. Subs and new members after the
first week of the league will figure average after three games
are bowled.
- 4 SCORING
Two points will be awarded for each game won, and one point for
series, for a total of seven points for three game series.
5. SUBSTITUTES
In sanctioned league, any sanctioned bowler may sub in accordance
with rule 2. No roving subs.
- 6 TARDY BOWLERS
Tardy bowlers will be allowed until the completion of the fifth
frame to catch up.
- 7 LEAGUE SCHEDULE
League will bowl a position round on last week of season. In
case of a tie for first place, a one game rolloff will be held
- 8 PRIZES
Each league will have a prize list posted, based on the league
strength and the total prize fund. Team prizes will be paid on a
handicap basis, if a handicap league. Individual prizes will be
paid on scratch scores. No team or individual may draw but one
special prize in each class (team or individual). Individuals
must have bowled at least 2/3 of the games scheduled, to be
eligible for individual prizes. Substitutes may not qualify for
individual awards. Most improved average awards (in sanctioned
leagues) will be taken after 12 games.

Only one high average, series, or game award per person to be
awarded in that order. However, WIBC high series pins will be
awarded to person bowling actual high series regardless of
other awards he/she may have won.

9 BLINDS

Blind score after the first week will use a score of 10 pins less than the absentee's average, but use absentees average to figure handicap. Vacancy score shall be 125.

10. FEES

Each team and individual member is responsible for their bowling and prize fee and must be paid whether present or absent. If not paid same will be deducted from prize fund or the team at the seasons end. League members who drop out must pay for two sessions of league fees if not replaced before two sessions are up. A bowler may not be more than two week in arrears in bowling fees. A Bowler that is two weeks in arrears is an ineligible player and may not bowl again until paid in full.

Teams may pre-bowl or make-up when a legal line-up can not be present at the regular time of bowling. Individuals may pre-bowl only. Teams bowling games last can not see scores of opposing team. Emergencies may be vacation interference, sickness, etc. Teams with possibility of winning championship on the last week of bowling shall bowl against each other (not unopposed). If time is not the regular bowling time, teams must arrange a time both can bowl each other.

New team joining the league after start of season may make-up games for first and second week of bowling. New teams replacing teams that drop out during season may make-up one week of bowling. Scores to be paired against team that bowled regular time.

13 Any rule not covered above will be governed by ABC, WIBC, or YABA standards. If not sanctioned league, all normal bowling rules apply.

Teams bowling unopposed must bowl within the following of their average to win each game: 2 members - 20 pins, 3 members -30 pins, 4 members - 40 pins.
